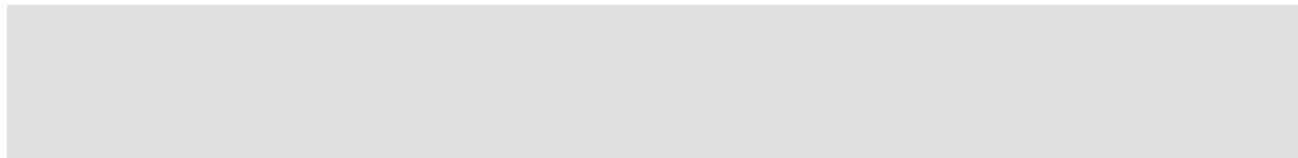

DID YOU KNOW SECTION.....

Did you know that we commenced an Inaugural Maiden Rider of the Year last year – this is for Adult Riders who have never won a draft and incorporates points gained in Maiden, Novice and Open events. It takes the place of the Encouragement Rider and the Ken Howlett Perpetual Trophy now incorporates this on the plaque.

Did you know that according to NCCA rule 2.7 “In the event of the beast breaking out of the face of the camp before the competitor calls for the gate, they must follow it. If the Judge considers the competitor has been unduly disadvantaged and has not significantly contributed to the breakout, a re-run may be award.”

Did you know that rule 4.1 states “the time limit for the completion of the course will be 40 seconds, and the start of a run is when a horse exits the cutout.”

Did you know that Rule 8.2 is “A Novice Horse is a horse which has won first prize in a Maiden, Novice, Ladies or restricted Campdraft and remains a Novice until the horse has won a further three (3) Novice drafts. A horse that has won an Open Campdraft ceases to be a Novice. A horse can win four (4) Novice drafts if it has not won first prize in a Maiden. All Associations will implement from the start of each Association’s points year. Once a horse has broken status in their Association that status is carried through to all Associations.”

And under General Requirements for all Campdrafts, Rule 1. States “All riders under the age of 18 years must wear properly fitted helmets (includes use of the chinstrap) with AS/NZS 3838:1998, and are less than five (5) years old from the date of manufacture.

JUDGES SCHOOL AT WELSHPOOL – PLEASE LET KEN, DARREN OR KAREN KNOW IF YOU ARE INTERESTED IN ATTENDING

Ken Boulton and Darren Goff will do the Judges Roster for season 2011/12 if you are interested in picking up the whip, read a copy of the rules just by going to our website www.gippslandcampdrafting.org.au, click on the N.C.C.A link on the front page, and follow the links to the Rules of Campdrafting) and put your name down for the Judges School at Welshpool.

As the great Quarterhorse Cutting Judge Max McTaggart once said, there are more judges on the outside of the fence than those with the whip.... So if you want to have a go, just let us know!

OUR LIFE MEMBERS

KEN HOWLETT was our Number 1 Life member however sadly passed away in 2005. Ken spent most of his early life in Bairnsdale and was one of the foundation members of the East Gippsland ASH Branch, as well as the GCA. Ken gained a reputation as a master horseman, and was an excellent role model, dominating the Stockhorse scene in East Gippsland for many years. He loved nothing better than encouraging all young riders in the sport of stockhorse showing or campdrafting.

AUB GOODMAN & SONNY DAVIS have been there right from the start and are staunch supporters of the GCA and the campdrafting fraternity. Aub lives at Garfield where he farms asparagus and breeds Stockhorses when not drafting. Aub is always competitive on his Trewarric stockhorses, although a knee operation slowed him down last season. Aub was especially proud of his horses this year when Trewarric Star ridden by Mat Holz won the GCA Maiden Championship 2011 event.

SONNY lives at Yarram and approximately 5 years ago, scaled down his dairying enterprise on the edge of town. Sonny was a very keen Open drafter with his mare Blue Jeans commencing in the 80s and together with Ken Boulton, was one of the first Gippslanders to draft in other states. Recurring illness has hampered Sonny in the past few years however he still breeds stockhorses and follows the campdrafts although daughter-in-law Christine now rides the horses.

JOANNE BODDY lives at Woodside with husband Peter and had the reputation of being the GCA's most esteemed Lady Rider until Multiple Sclerosis made it impossible for Jo to continue riding. In her youth, Jo often was one of the youngest to win the Juniors as well as the Ladies in a weekend of drafting. Jo has certainly won her share of Maiden, Novice & Open events over the years. Jo has a ton of campdrafting commonsense and her sense of humour often sees many people spending time in the Boddy Gooseneck.

PHYL SUTTON was GCA's Secretary for many years and together with husband Peter, commenced drafting in the 80s, making the very long trip to many drafts from their home at Combiobar in the east of the State. Phyl and Peter have since retired from drafting and have purchased a property at Buchan, however both can still be seen at drafts, and it is always a pleasure to catch up with Phyl, who together with Peter can recount many funny stories of drafting in times gone by.

KEN BOULTON is currently still competing and enjoys the record of winning GCA Champion Rider for an unbroken stint of 15 years. Ken and wife Alison have farms at Stradbroke and Warragul, however do spend a lot of time on the road traveling to a draft whether it is here or in other states. Ken is passionate about the GCA, taking on the President's role on numerous occasions over the years, as well as representing it at many prestigious events over the years, including at Warwick and Paradise Lagoons.

RON CONNLEY lives at Omeo where he runs cattle and sheep on the steep slopes of his property Bingo with wife Avril. One of the founding members of the GCA, he has also been President on numerous occasions since 1975. Ron is a fierce competitor, winning many events over the years and shows no sign of slowing down. Ron is a keen rodeo and stockman's challenge competitor, and regularly competes in these events on his hardy stockhorses.

DENNIS NEAL runs a beef and sheep property at Flynn with wife Kaye. Dennis commenced drafting as well as showing stockhorses in the 80s, and made a name for himself by winning many prestigious stockhorse events and has been an integral part of the Stockhorse Society. Dennis loves campdrafting as it involves his whole family and is especially proud to see his grandchildren competing. Dennis is also renown for his very well bred kelpie dogs and has just returned from Casterton where he won the Kelpie Working Dog Muster with his trusty companions, Stockhorse Jolson and Kelpie Pomanda Rod.

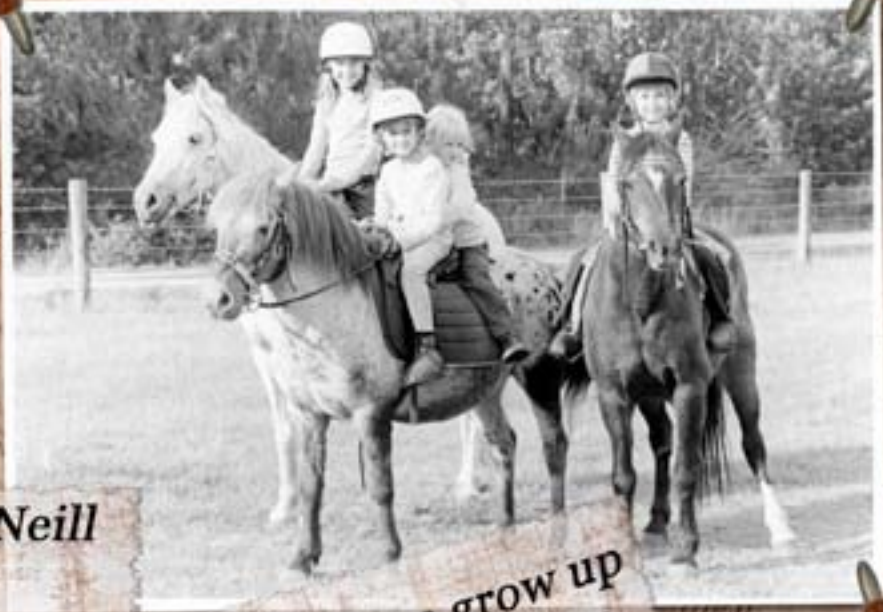

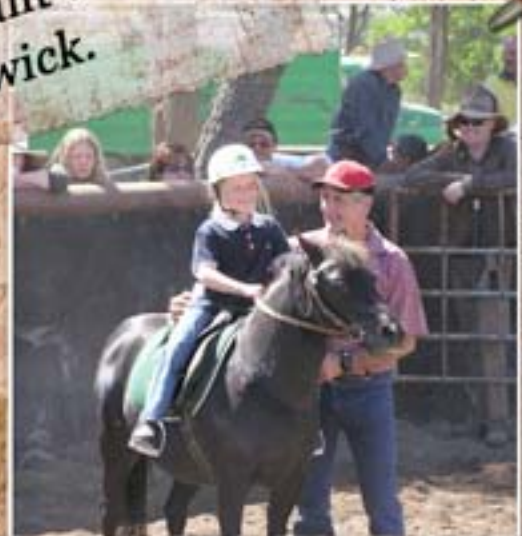
